

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Coburn Street, Hardwick Lane and The Twitchell, Sutton-in-Ashfield) (Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2019 (4242)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Sutton-in-Ashfield in the District of Ashfield: -

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at any time along: -

COBURN STREET, SUTTON-IN-ASHFIELD (both sides)

- From its junction with The Twitchell in an easterly direction for 10 metres
- From its junction with Hardwick Lane in a westerly direction for 10 metres

HARDWICK LANE, SUTTON-IN-ASHFIELD (the west side)

- From a point 10 metres north of its junction with Coburn Street in a southerly direction to a point 10 metres south of that junction

THE TWITCHELL, SUTTON-IN-ASHFIELD (the east side)

- From a point 13 metres north of its junction with Coburn Street in a southerly direction to a point 10 metres south of that junction

2. Other restrictions: - **Bus Stop Clearway** – No Stopping, except buses At Any time

THE TWITCHELL, SUTTON-IN-ASHFIELD

- (west side) **Bus Stop AS0639** – from a point opposite a point 37 metres north of its junction with Coburn Street in a northerly direction for 19 metres
- (east side) **Bus Stop AS0640** – from a point 13 metres north of its junction with Coburn Street in a northerly direction for 17 metres

The clearways would prohibit stopping by all vehicles, at any times except buses. The clearways will be identified by new road markings and signage.
