

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Cross Lane, Unnamed Road and William Hall Way, Newark) (Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2019 (3307)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads, in the District of Newark and Sherwood: -

Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at any time along the following lengths of road: -

CROSS LANE, NEWARK (both sides)

• From its junction with B6326 in a south westerly direction to its south-western extremity.

UNAMED ROAD, NEWARK (both sides)

• From its junction with William Hall Way in a north-westerly direction to its north-western extremity.

WILLIAM HALL WAY, NEWARK (both sides)

From its junction with B6326 in a south-westerly then southerly direction to a point 44
metres south of the outside perimeter of the roundabout with Cross Lane
