

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Ireland Avenue and Redwood Crescent, Beeston) (Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2021 (5298)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respect of roads at Beeston in the Borough of Broxtowe: -

Vehicles will be prohibited from Waiting At Any Time along the following lengths of road: -

<u>Ireland Avenue, Beeston</u> (the south-east side)

• From a point 9 metres south-west of its junction with Redwood Crescent in a north-easterly direction to a point 8 metres north-east of that junction.

Redwood Crescent, Beeston

(the north-east side)

- From its junction with Ireland Avenue in a south-easterly direction for 12 metres
- From its junction with the north-west side of Redwood Crescent in a north-westerly direction for 10 metres

(the south-west side)

- From its junction with Ireland Avenue in a south-easterly direction for 12 metres
- From its junction with the north-west side of Redwood Crescent in a north-westerly direction for 10 metres

(the north-west side)

 From a point 10 metres south-west of its junction with Redwood Crescent in a north-easterly direction to a point 10 metres north-east of that junction.

As a result of the impact of COVID-19 and in accordance with Public Health England's advice on social distancing and avoiding non-essential trips, public buildings such at County Hall and Libraries are closed or if reopened will have restrictions in place.
