

The Nottinghamshire County Council (New Hill, Walesby) (Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2020 (3312)

<u>NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN</u> that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Walesby in the District of Newark and Sherwood: -

Vehicles will be prohibited from Waiting At Any Time along the following lengths of road: -

NEW HILL, WALESBY (the north side)

from its junction with Retford Road in a south-easterly direction for 13 metres.

NEW HILL, WALESBY (the south side)

• from its junction with Retford Road in a south-easterly direction for 13 metres.

As a result of the impact of COVID-19 and in accordance with Public Health England's advice on social distancing and avoiding non-essential trips, public buildings such at County Hall libraries are closed or if reopened will have restrictions in place.
