

## **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**

## The Nottinghamshire County Council (Maundale Avenue and Unwin Road, Sutton-in-Ashfield) (Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2019 (4236)

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Sutton-in-Ashfield in the District of Ashfield: -

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at any time along: -

## MAUNDALE AVENUE, SUTTON-IN-ASHFIELD (both sides)

From its junction with Unwin Road in a north-westerly direction for 10 metres

## <u>UNWIN ROAD, SUTTON-IN-ASHFIELD</u> (the north-west side)

• From a point 10 metres south-west of its junction with Maundale Avenue in a northeasterly direction to a point 10 metres north-east of that junction
