

The Nottinghamshire County Council
(Dykes End, High Street, Swinderby Road and Woodhill Road, Collingham)
(Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2018 (3287)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Collingham in the District of Newark and Sherwood:-

Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at any time along the following lengths of road: -

Dykes End, Collingham (north side)

From its junction with High Street in an easterly direction for 15 metres.

Dykes End, Collingham (south side)

From its junction with High Street in an easterly direction for 17metres.

High Street, Collingham (eastern side)

From a point 7 metres north east of its junction with Dykes End in a south westerly direction to a point 16 metres southwest of that junction.

From a point 12 metres north east of its junction with Swinderby Road in a south westerly direction to a point 17 metres south west of that junction.

From a point 11 metres north of its junction with Woodhill Road in a southerly direction to a point 11 metres south of that junction.

Swinderby Road, Collingham (both sides)

From its junction with High Street in an easterly direction for 31 metres.

Woodhill Road, Collingham (north side)

From its junction with High Street in an north easterly direction for 18 metres.

Woodhill Road, Collingham (south side)

From its junction with High Street in an north easterly direction for 17 metres.
