

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BOWBRIDGE LANE, FLAXLEY LANE AND SPINNERS WAY, BALDERTON) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND NO STOPPING ON ENTRANCE CLEARWAYS) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2021 (3330)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Balderton in the District of Newark and Sherwood

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at any time along the following: -

BOWBRIDGE ROAD, BALDERTON (east side)

• from a point 19 metres south of its junction with Flaxley Lane in a north-westerly direction to a point 36 metres north-west of that junction.

FLAXLEY LANE, BALDERTON (north side)

- from its junction with Bowbridge Lane in an easterly direction for 28 metres.
- from a point 7 metres opposite the eastern kerb line of Spinners Way in a south-westerly and then westerly direction of 33 metres.

FLAXLEY LANE, BALDERTON (south side)

- from its junction with Bowbridge Lane in an easterly direction for 28 metres.
- from a point 28 metres east of its junction with Spinners Way in an easterly direction to a point 85 metres north-east of that junction.

SPINNERS WAY, BALDERTON (east side)

• from its junction with Flaxley Lane in a southerly direction for 12 metres.

SPINNERS WAY, BALDERTON (west side)

- from its junction with Flaxley Lane in a southerly direction for 17 metres.
- 2. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting between Mon-Fri 8am-4.30pm along the following: -

FLAXLEY LANE, BALDERTON (north side)

- from a point 28 metres east of its junction with Bowbridge Lane in an easterly then north-easterly direction for 60 metres.
- from a point 7 metres opposite the eastern kerb line of Spinners Way in a south-westerly and then westerly direction of 33 metres.
- 3. Vehicles will be prohibited from stopping on school entrance markings on Monday to Friday between 8am and 4.30pm along the following: -

FLAXLEY LANE, BALDERTON (north side)

- from a point 98 metres east of its junction with Bowbridge Lane in a north-easterly direction for 68 metres.
- from a point 199 metres east of its junction with Bowbridge Lane in an easterly direction for 31 metres.

BOWBRIDGE ROAD, BALDERTON (east side)

- from a point 36 metres east of its junction with Bowbridge Lane in a north-westerly direction for 26 metres.
- 4. Other restrictions

FLAXLEY LANE, BALDERTON (north side) (Bus Stop Clearway)

• from a point 253 metres east of its junction with Bowbridge Lane in a north-easterly direction for 19 metres.

As a result of the impact of COVID-19 and in accordance with Public Health England's advice on social distancing and avoiding non-essential trips, public buildings such at County Hall libraries are closed or if reopened will have restrictions in place.
