

**The Nottinghamshire County Council (Halam Road, Kirklington Road and  
Wolsey Close, Southwell) (Prohibition of Waiting)  
Traffic Regulation Order 2021 (3342)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Southwell in the District of Newark and Sherwood: -

Vehicles will be prohibited from **Waiting At Any Time** along the following lengths of road: -

**Halam Road, Southwell** (the north-east side)

- From its junction with Kirklington Road in a westerly direction for 18 metres

**Halam Road, Southwell** (the south-west side)

- From a point 10 metres north-west of its junction with Wolsey Close in a south-easterly direction to a point 10 metres south-east of that junction.

**Kirklington Road, Southwell** (the north-east side)

- From its junction with Queen Street in a north-westerly direction for 49 metres

**Kirklington Road, Southwell** (the south west side)

- From its junction with Queen Street in a north-westerly direction for 34 metres

**Wolsey Close, Southwell** (both sides)

- From its junction with Halam Road in a south-easterly direction for 10 metres.
