Proposed Parking Restrictions (TRO 7250)

Wood Lane and Yew Tree Lane, Gedling.

PUBLIC ADVERT

Via East Midlands Ltd, is working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council to deliver highway services in Nottinghamshire. Concerns have been raised about obstructive parking along Wood Lane especially at the entrances to Carlton Le Willows Academy and Daisies Day Nursery and at the junctions of Wood Lane /Yew Tree Lane and Wood Lane/ Shearing Hill, Gedling. This reduces visibility and access for drivers and pedestrians using these junctions and travelling along Wood Lane.

To help alleviate these problems it is proposed to introduce 'No Waiting At Any Time' restrictions (Double Yellow Lines) at the junctions and No Waiting Mon-Fri 8am-6pm (Single Yellow Lines) along the south side of Wood Lane, as shown on drawing number H/JA/3885/01. Before proceeding further, I wish to consider the views of residents, businesses and organisations who may be interested in this matter.

Any observations on these proposals should reach me in writing, either by letter or email, by **29**th **April 2022**. If your comments are in the form of an objection to the proposals, please clearly state this and the reasons for your objection. If the objection cannot be resolved, it will be reported through the County Council's procedures at the appropriate time.
