

**The Nottinghamshire County Council**  
**(Wood Lane and Yew Tree Lane, Gedling)**  
**(Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2022 (7250)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Gedling in the Borough of Gedling: -

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from **Waiting At Any Time** along the following lengths of road: -

**Wood Lane, Gedling** (north side)

- From its junction with Main Road in a north easterly direction for 21 metres.
- From a point opposite a point 23 metres north-east of the northern kerb line of Carlton le Willows Academy in a south westerly direction for 16 metres.

**Wood Lane, Gedling** (south side)

- From its junction with Shearing Hill in a north- easterly direction for 14 metres.
- From the northern kerb line of the entrance of Carlton le Willows Academy in a northerly direction for 14 metres.

**Yew Tree Lane, Gedling** (the north-east side)

- From its junction with Wood Lane in a north-westerly direction for 10 metres.

**Yew Tree Lane, Gedling** (the south-west side)

- From its junction with Wood Lane in a north-westerly direction for 10 metres.

2. Vehicles will be prohibited from **Waiting Mon-Fri 8am-6pm** along the following lengths of road: -

**Wood Lane, Gedling** (south side)

- From a point 14 metres north-east of its junction with Shearing Hill in a north-easterly direction for 310 metres.
