

PROPOSED PUBLIC REALM MEASURES IN KIRKBY IN ASHFIELD


Via East Midlands Ltd, is working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council to deliver highway services in Nottinghamshire. In response to the unprecedented situation due to COVID-19, the Government has requested Local Highway Authorities make changes to their road layouts to encourage active travel and enable social distancing.

In response the following **temporary** measure is proposed to mitigate the effects of COVID-19 in Kirkby in Ashfield:

• Suspension of four limited waiting parking bays and one disabled parking bay on the southern side of Station Street, between Lime Street and Tennyson Street.

Conversion of a section of an existing limited waiting bay on the northern side of Station Street (outside

no. 13 Station Street) into a disabled parking bay.



As part of the work barriers will be erected to close four laybys on the southern side of Station Street to vehicles. The roadspace will be reallocated for pedestrian use to facilitate appropriate social distancing within the town centre. The proposals would be introduced through a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (TTRO) and are being funded directly from central Government. It is anticipated that the measures may remain in place for a period of up to 12 months. Further information on the proposals is available:
