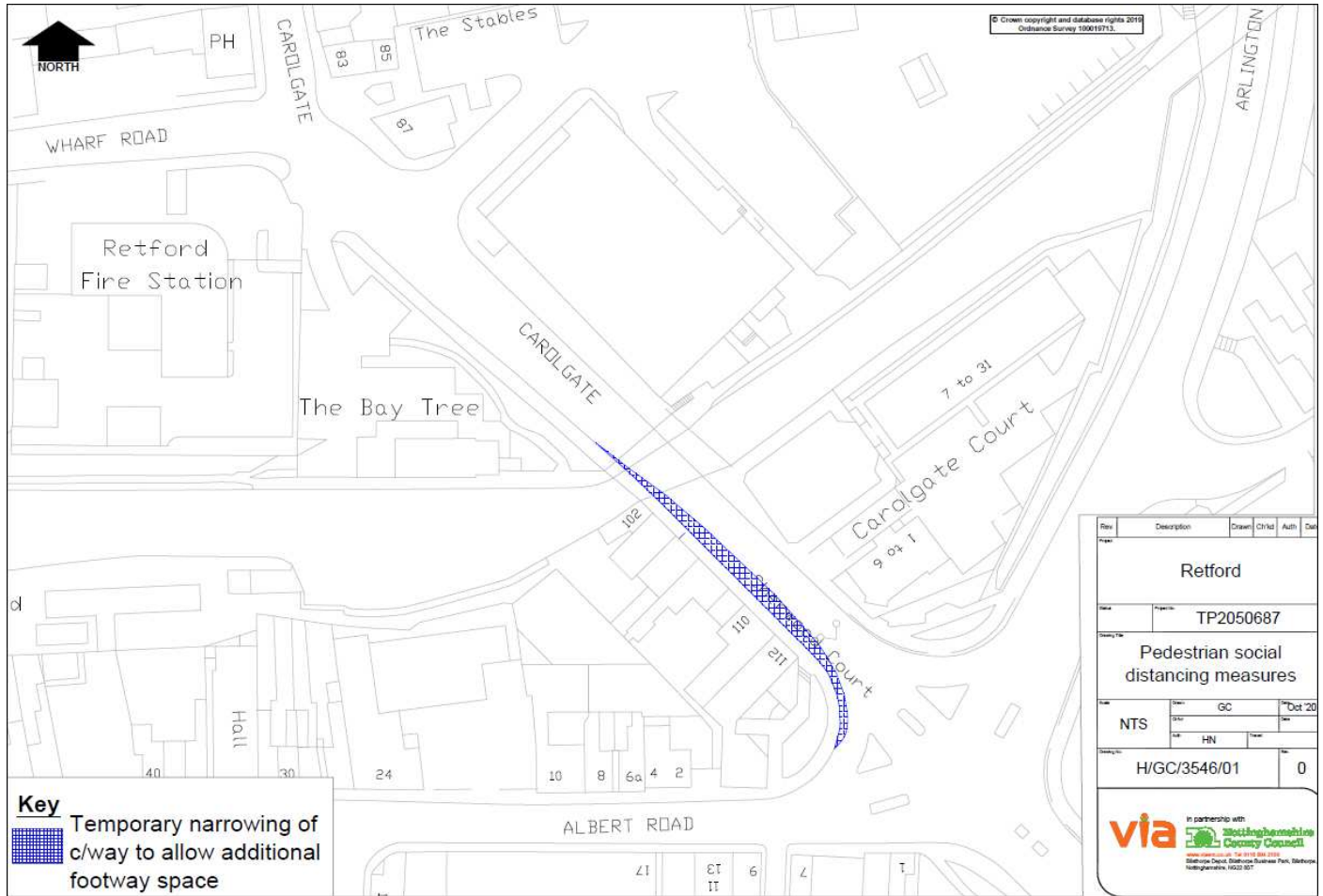


PROPOSED PUBLIC REALM MEASURES IN RETFORD

Via East Midlands Ltd, is working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council to deliver highway services in Nottinghamshire. In response to the unprecedented situation due to COVID-19, the Government has requested Local Highway Authorities make changes to their road layouts to encourage active travel and enable social distancing.

In response the following **temporary** measure is proposed to mitigate the effects of COVID-19 in Retford:

- Narrowing of the carriageway on south-western side of Carolgate from approximately the canal bridge to Arlington Way.



As part of the work barriers will be erected to narrow the nearside lane on the south-western side. The roadspace will be reallocated for pedestrian use to facilitate appropriate social distancing within the town centre. The proposals would be introduced through a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (TTRO) and are being funded directly from central Government. It is anticipated that the measures may remain in place for a period of up to 12 months, the scheme will be monitored and reviewed as appropriate.
