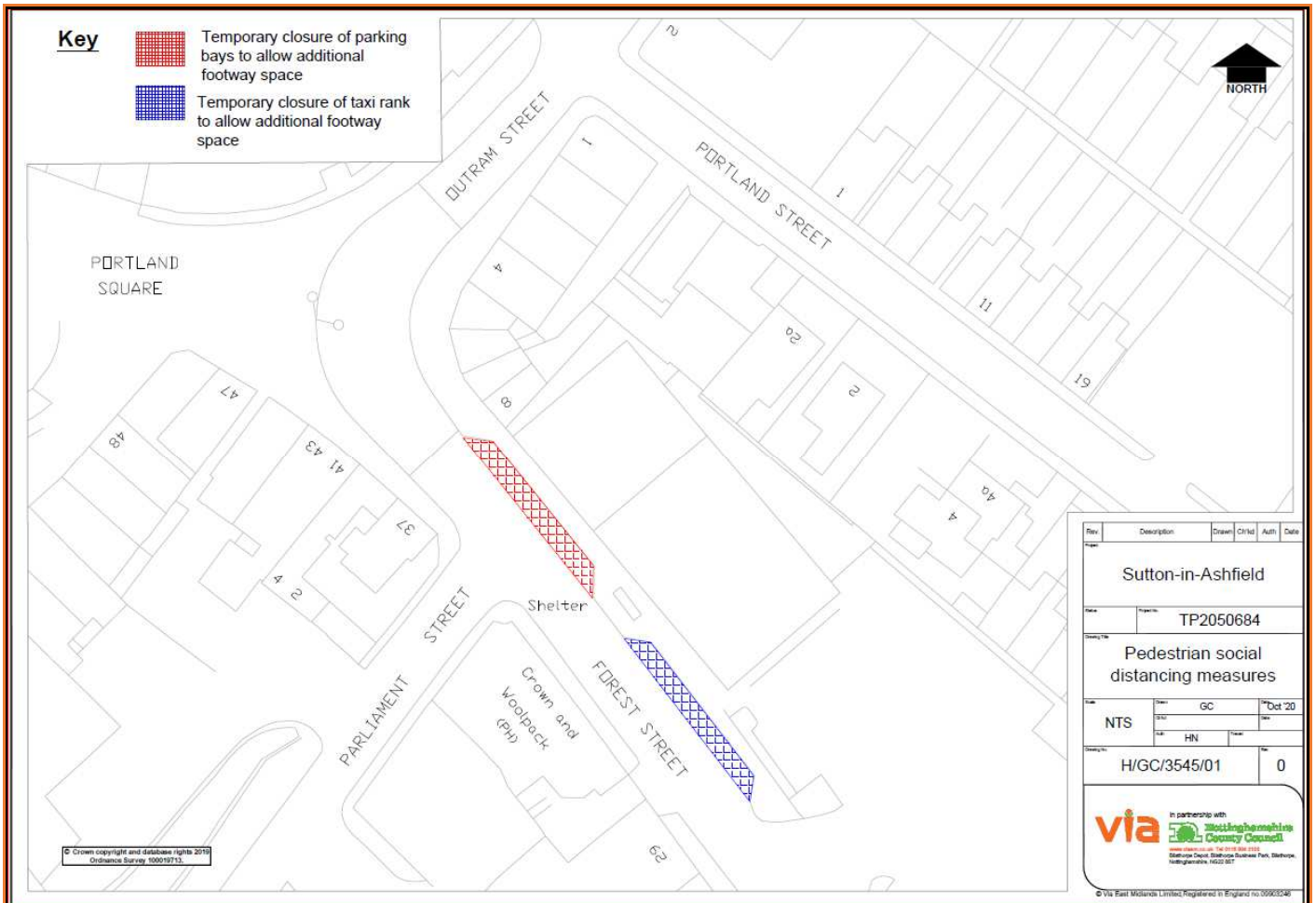


PROPOSED PUBLIC REALM MEASURES IN SUTTON IN ASHFIELD

Via East Midlands Ltd, is working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council to deliver highway services in Nottinghamshire. In response to the unprecedented situation due to COVID-19, the Government has requested Local Highway Authorities make changes to their road layouts to encourage active travel and enable social distancing.

In response the following **temporary** measure is proposed to mitigate the effects of COVID-19 in Sutton in Ashfield:

- Suspension of a limited waiting parking bay and a taxi rank on Forest Street, Sutton in Ashfield.



The roadspace will be reallocated for pedestrian use to facilitate appropriate social distancing within the town centre. As part of the work barriers will be erected to close the laybys to vehicles. The scheme will be introduced under a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (TTRO) and it is anticipated that the measures may remain in place for a period of up to 12 months, the scheme will be monitored and reviewed as appropriate.
