

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Balderton Gate, Newark on Trent)
(Parking Places and Residents' Controlled Zone)
Traffic Regulation Order 2021 (3313)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be to roads in Newark on Trent in the District of Newark and Sherwood:-

1. To provide residents' parking places operating Monday to Saturday 9am to 5pm along

BALDERTON GATE (NEWARK ON TRENT) (north-east side)

- from a point 33 metres north-west of its junction with William Street in a south-easterly direction to a point 8 metres north-west of its junction with William Street.
- from a point 8 metres south-east of its junction with William Street in a south-easterly direction to a point 14 metres north-west of its junction with Whitfield Street.

BALDERTON GATE (NEWARK ON TRENT) (south-west side)

- from a point 33 metres south-east of its junction with Sherwood Avenue in a south-easterly direction for 18 metres

2. To provide 2 hours parking, no return within 1 hour. Operating Monday to Saturday 9am – 5pm along: -

BALDERTON GATE (NEWARK ON TRENT) (north-east side)

- from a point 53 metres north-west of its junction with William Street in a south-easterly direction for 20 metres.
- from a point 33 metres north-west of its junction with William Street in a south-easterly direction to a point 8 metres north-west of its junction with William Street.
- from a point 8 metres south-east of its junction with William Street in a south-easterly direction to a point 14 metres north-west of its junction with Whitfield Street.

BALDERTON GATE (NEWARK ON TRENT) (south-west side)

- from a point 33 metres south-east of its junction with Sherwood Avenue in a south-easterly direction for 18 metres.

As a result of the impact of COVID-19 and in accordance with Public Health England's advice on social distancing and avoiding non-essential trips, public buildings such as County Hall libraries are closed or if reopened will have restrictions in place.

Written comments / objections (stating grounds and quoting ref. 3313) must be received by me by **2nd day of April 2021**. Any details you provide may be shared with Nottinghamshire County Council as appropriate.

The provision is required to improve parking facilities for residents by introducing dual purpose parking bays, which restricts non-resident parking to up to 2 hours.
