

## The Nottinghamshire County Council (Penniment Lane, Sutton-in-Ashfield) (Restricted Road (30 M.P.H. Speed Limit)) Order 2019 (4240)

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects to roads in Sutton-in-Ashfield in the District of Ashfield:-

The following length of **Penniment Lane (the north-east to south-west section)** at Sutton-in-Ashfield in the District of Ashfield is to be a restricted road

from its junction with Penniment Lane (the north-west to south-east section) in a south-westerly direction for 290 metres to its south-western extremity.

This section of Penniment Lane remained as a derestricted road after the local road layout was changed. However, it is now proposed to make the road a restricted road and therefore subject to the lower speed limit of 30 m.p.h. which is considered the most appropriate for a residential street of this nature
