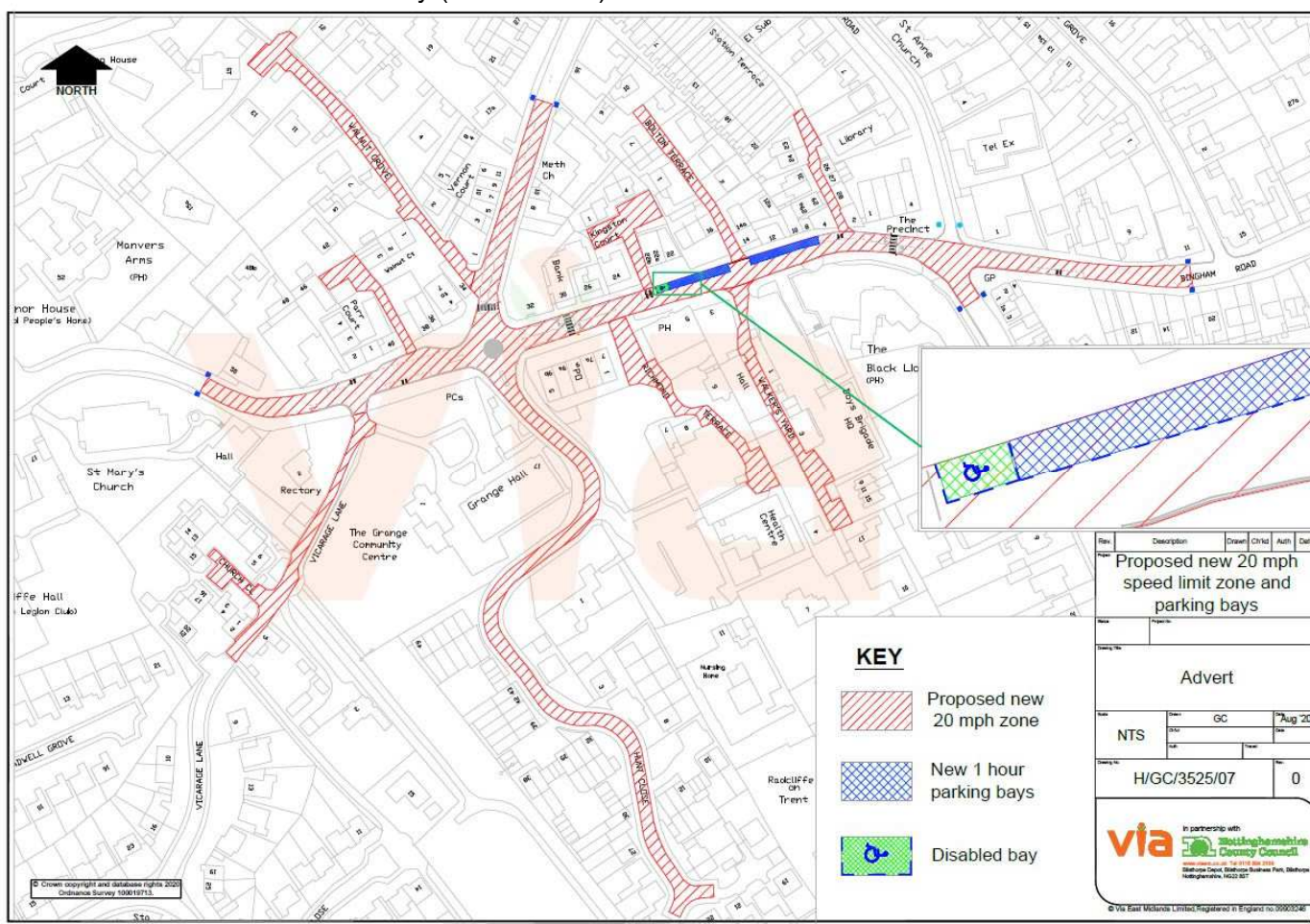


PROPOSED PUBLIC REALM MEASURES IN RADCLIFFE ON TRENT

Via East Midlands Ltd, is working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council to deliver highway services in Nottinghamshire. In response to the unprecedented situation due to COVID-19, the Government has requested Local Highway Authorities make changes to their road layouts to support the country's transition as lockdown restrictions are lifted. These changes include the introduction of measures to encourage active travel, enable social distancing and support economic recovery.

Rushcliffe Borough Council and Radcliffe on Trent Parish Council have requested that the following **temporary** measures be given consideration to mitigate the effects of COVID-19 in Radcliffe:

- 20mph zone within village centre
- Introduction of limited waiting (1hr) parking bays on a section of Main Road (Monday – Saturday 8.00am-6.00pm, 1 hour). An existing disabled parking bay on Main Road will also be converted into an enforceable bay (At All Times)



The measures would be introduced through a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (TTRO) and as part of this work new lines will be marked on site and new signs erected. Further information on the proposals is available:
