

PROPOSED ZEBRA CROSSING – RECTORY ROAD, WEST BRIDGFORD

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (Zebra crossing), proposes to install a zebra pedestrian crossing across Rectory Road, West Bridgford, in the Borough of Rushcliffe.

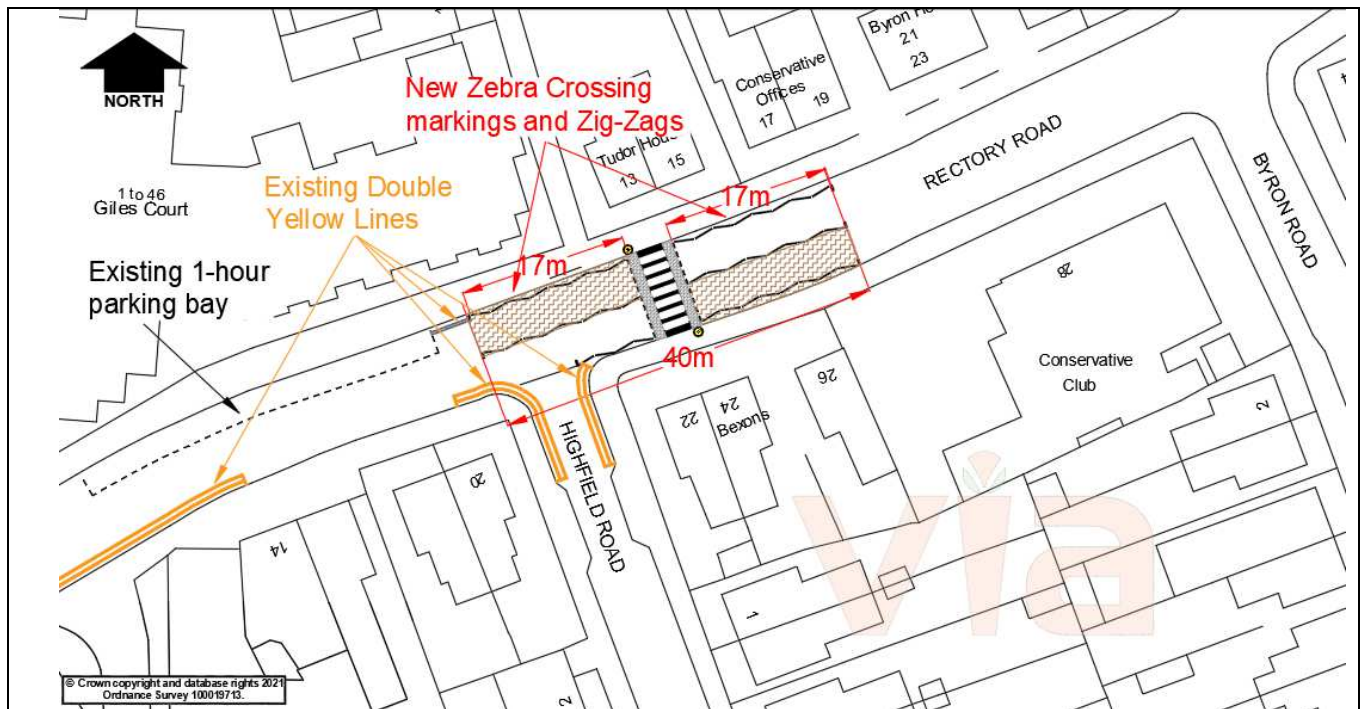
The crossing will incorporate a controlled area indicated by zig-zag markings along the carriageway where parking and loading will be prohibited at all times. The extents of the controlled area are: -

RECTORY ROAD (north-west side)

- from a point approximately 6 metres south-west of its junction with Highfield Road in a north-easterly direction for 40 metres

RECTORY ROAD (south-east side)

- from a point approximately 6 metres south-west of its junction with Highfield Road in a north-easterly direction for 40 metres



The crossing is being installed to assist pedestrians crossing the road.
