

## **ADBOLTON LANE / REGATTA WAY – PROVISION OF TRAFFIC CALMING**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of powers under Section 90A and 90I of the Highways Act 1980, propose to install a 75mm high raised plateau across the junction of Adbolton Lane with Regatta Way, West Bridgford.

The extents of the raised plateau are: -

### **ADBOLTON LANE, WEST BRIDGFORD**

- From its junction with Regatta Way in a north-westerly direction for approximately 12 metres
