

The Nottinghamshire County Council (College Road, Digby Avenue, Grover Avenue, Hazel Grove, Holyoake Avenue, Lambley Avenue, Plains Road, Shelford Road, Steedman Avenue and Westdale Lane West, Mapperley/Gedling)(Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2019 (7215)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be to roads in Mapperley and Gedling in the Borough of Gedling:-

Proposed No waiting at any time restrictions (double yellow lines) at the following junctions:-

- 1. Plains Road and Hazel Grove
- 2. Plains Road and Steedman Avenue
- 3. **Hazel Grove** and **Digby Avenue**
- 4. Westdale Lane West and Grover Avenue
- Westdale Lane West and Hazel Grove
- 6. **Digby Avenue** and **College Road**
- 7. **Digby Avenue** and **Lambley Avenue**
- 8. **Digby Avenue** and **Shelford Road**
- 9. **Digby Avenue** and **Holyoake Road**

<u>Proposed School Keep Clear restrictions – No Stopping on Monday to Friday between 8am and 4.30pm</u>

10. Hazel Grove (north-west side)

from a point 18 metres north-east of its junction with Westdale Lane West in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 26 metres.

The double yellow lines are being introduced to remove parked vehicles from the junctions described above The restrictions will give an unobstructed view for vehicles turning into or out of the junctions and allow pedestrians, especially local school children, to cross the road without having to negotiate parked vehicles. The proposed school keep clear is to ensure the school entrance is kept clear of all vehicles.
