ROLLESTON DRIVE, ARNOLD PROPOSED DOUBLE YELLOW LINES (NO WAITING AT ANY TIME) AND BUS STOP CLEARWAYS (NO STOPPING AT ANY TIME, EXCEPT BUSES) – TRO 7244

Via East Midlands Ltd, working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council, is proposing to introduce double yellow lines (no waiting at any time) and bus stop clearways (no stopping at any time, except buses) on Rolleston Drive, Arnold. The new restrictions are being introduced as part of the new housing development located on the old depot site off Rolleston Drive. The proposals are located on Rolleston Drive between the junctions with Brookfield Drive and Brook Avenue.

The proposed double yellow lines are intended to keep the junctions into the new development clear of parked vehicles to ensure that vehicles turning onto Rolleston Drive have a clear view of approaching traffic. The removal of parked vehicles will also give a clear route for pedestrians to cross the road at the new junctions.

The bus stop clearways are proposed for the following locations:-

- Bus stop GE0393 outside The Major Oak PH 17 metres long
- Bus stop GE0394 opposite 124 128, Rolleston Drive 19 metres long
- Bus stop GE0383 outside 98/100, Rolleston Drive 17 metres long

The main benefits of bus stop clearways are to:

- Help the bus align with the kerb to enable better access for disabled passengers and pushchair users;
- Ease congestion as a correctly aligned bus will not block the road for other road users;
- Ensure that bus drivers discharge their duty to drop passengers off on the kerb and not on the road:
- Ensure that bus services operate on time and are not unnecessarily delayed.

Before proceeding further with the proposed double yellow lines and bus stop clearways, I wish to consider the views of residents and organisations who may be interested in this matter. If your comments are in the form of an objection to the proposals and if they cannot be resolved, they will be reported through the County Council's procedures at the appropriate time. Any observations on these proposals should reach me by **5**th **November 2021**.
