

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (SCAFTWORTH HALL ROAD, SCAFTWORTH)
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2025 (1324)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Scaftworth in the Borough of Bassetlaw: -

1. Proposed **prohibition from Waiting At Any Time** along the following length of roads: -

Scaftworth Hall Road, Scaftworth (east and north-east side)

- From a point opposite a point 1 meter south of the southern building line of the King William Public House in a southerly and south-easterly direction for 88 metres

Scaftworth Hall Road, Scaftworth (south-west side)

- From a point 33 metres south of the southern building line of King William Public House in a south-easterly direction for 20 metres.
