**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council **HAS MADE** an order under the road traffic regulation act 1984, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads in Little Carlton in District of Newark and Sherwood: -

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on: -

**A616 Ollerton Road, Little Carlton and South Muskham**

From a point 20 metres south-east of its junction with Ollerton Road (Western Arm) to a point 25 metres west of its roundabout junction with B6325 Great North Road
