

## The Nottinghamshire County Council (Mansfield Road (B6030), Clipstone and King's Clipstone) (50 M.P.H. Speed Limit) Order 2021 (3308)

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council HAS MADE an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be to roads in Clipstone and King's Clipstone in the District of Newark and Sherwood:-

## Mansfield Road (B6030) in Clipstone and King's Clipstone in the District of Newark and Sherwood

1. from a point 74 metres north-east of its junction with Baulker Lane in a north-easterly direction to a point 187 metres south-west of the centre line with its junction with Gorsethorpe Lane.

As a result of the impact of COVID-19 and in accordance with Public Health England's advice on social distancing and avoiding non-essential trips, public buildings such at County Hall and libraries are closed or if reopened will have restrictions in place.

The lower speed limit has replaced the previous National Speed Limit (60mph) between Clipstone and King's Clipstone. The lower speed limit will help to reduce the speed of the traffic approaching the existing 30mph speed limits and approaching the Cavendish Way roundabout.
