

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Arnold Lane, Colliery Way (Gedling Access Road), Mapperley Plains and Spring Lane, Arnold, Lambley and Mapperley)(30 M.P.H. Speed Limit) Restricted Road Order 2022 (7248)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council HAS MADE an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Arnold, Lambley and Mapperley in the Borough of Gedling:-

- 1. The following lengths of road shall be a **restricted road** (30mph):-
- (i) <u>Arnold Lane in Mapperley</u> from its junction with Mapperley Plains in a south-easterly direction for 31 metres.
- (ii) <u>Colliery Way (Gedling Access Road) in Mapperley</u> from its junction with Mapperley Plains in a south-easterly direction for 41 metres.
- (iii) Mapperley Plains (B684) in Mapperley and Arnold from its junction with Plains Road (B683) in a north-easterly direction to a point 81 metres north-east of its junction with Spring Lane, as measured along the centre line.
- (iv) Plains Road (B684) in Mapperley and Arnold from a point 98 metres south-west of the south-western kerb line of Gedling Road (A6211) in a north-easterly direction to its junction with Mapperley Plains (B683).
- (v) Spring Lane in Lambley and Mapperley from its junction with Mapperley Plains (the outer perimeter of the mini-roundabout) in south-easterly direction for 42 metres (as measured along the centre line)

The speed limit has replaced the previous 40mph speed limit. The lower speed limit will help to reduce the speed of traffic approaching the mini roundabout at Spring Lane and the new junction with the Colliery Way (Gedling Access Road). Lower speeds give more time for drivers to react to turning vehicles.
