

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Bonner Hill, Calverton and Foxwood Lane, Woodborough) (50 M.P.H. Speed Limit) Order 2021 (7237A)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes HAS MADE an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effects of which will be to roads in Calverton and Woodborough in the Borough of Gedling:-

No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the following lengths of road:-

Bonner Hill and Foxwood Lane

1. from a point 107 metres south of its junction with Church Meadow (Calverton) in southerly and then a south-easterly direction to a point 236 metres north-west of its junction with Bank Hill (Woodborough).

The new 50mph speed limit is intended to reduce the speed of traffic to reflect the bendy and hilly nature of the road. The lower speed limit will help make the road safer for cyclists, horse riders and pedestrians. Reduced traffic speeds will give more time for drivers to react to vehicles turning onto or off Bonner Hill or Foxwood Lane.
