

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Mount Pleasant, Carlton)(Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2022 (7249A)(REVISED)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council HAS MADE an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be to roads in Carlton in the Borough of Gedling:-

1. Proposed **No waiting at any time** restrictions (double yellow lines) at the following locations:-

(i) MOUNT PLEASANT (EAST TO WEST SECTION)(both sides)

from its junction with Southdale Road in an easterly direction to its junction with the north-south section of Mount Pleasant.

(ii) MOUNT PLEASANT (NORTH TO SOUTH SECTION)(the east side)

from the northern property boundary of 27 Mount Pleasant in a northerly direction for a distance of 11 metres.

(iii) MOUNT PLEASANT (NORTH TO SOUTH SECTION)(the west side)

from its junction with Mount Pleasant (East to West section) in a southerly direction for a distance of 17 metres.

The double yellow lines have been introduced to remove parked vehicles from Mount Pleasant at its junction with Southdale Road. The main aim of the restrictions is to keep the road clear to allow the passage of larger vehicles, especially the refuse lorries. The double yellow lines to the north of number 27 are to help ensure that the refuse lorries can turn round.
