

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (ARNOLD LANE, BURTON ROAD, COLLIERY WAY (GEDLING ACCESS ROAD) AND LAMBLEY LANE, GEDLING)(40MPH SPEED LIMIT AND RESTRICTED ROAD) ORDER 2022 (7223)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council HAS MADE an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be to roads in Gedling in the Borough of Gedling:-

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding **40 miles per hour** on the lengths of roads shown below:-
 - (i) Arnold Lane - from a point 31 metres south-east of its junction with Mapperley Plains in a south-easterly direction to a point 167 metres NW of the outer perimeter of the roundabout junction with Colliery Way (Gedling Access Road).
 - (ii) Burton Road - from its junction with Colliery Way (Gedling Access Road) in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 43 metres.
 - (iii) Colliery Way (Gedling Access Road) - from a point 41 metres south-east of its junction with Mapperley Plains in a south-easterly direction to a point 123 metres NW of the outer perimeter of the roundabout junction with Arnold Lane.
 - (iv) Colliery Way (Gedling Access Road) - from a point 53 metres south-east of the outer perimeter of the roundabout junction with Waldrom Road in a south-easterly direction to its junction with Trent Valley Road (A612).
 - (v) Lambley Lane - from its junction with Colliery Way (Gedling Access Road) in a north-easterly direction to a point 87 metres south-west of its junction with Spring Lane.
2. The lengths of road specified below shall be a **restricted road** for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act (30mph speed limit):-
 - (i) Arnold Lane - from a point 167 metres north-west of the outer perimeter of the roundabout junction with Colliery Way (Gedling Access Road) in a south-easterly direction to a point 68 metres south-east of the centre line of its junction with High Hazels Close.
 - (ii) Colliery Way (Gedling Access Road) - from a point 123 metres north-west of the outer perimeter of the roundabout junction with Arnold Lane in an easterly direction to a point 53 metres south-east of the outer perimeter of the roundabout junction with Waldrom Road.

The new speed limits on Colliery Way (Gedling Access Road) have been introduced to reflect the nature and design of the new road. The new 30mph speed limit on Arnold Lane is to reflect the road ceasing to be an A road and becoming a quieter residential road.
