

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Rempstone Road, East Leake) (40 M.P.H. Speed Limit) Order 2022 (8301)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council HAS MADE an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be to roads in East Leake in the Borough of Rushcliffe:-

Rempstone Road in East Leake in the Borough of Rushcliffe

1. from a point 40 metres north-west of its junction with Loughborough Road in a north-westerly direction to a point 25 metres south-east of its junction with Kirk Ley Road.

To the north-west of the Loughborough Road junction a 40mph speed limit has been introduced. The limit starts from near the junction and extends in a north-westerly direction to finish at the start of the existing 30mph speed limit. The new limit reflects the changing nature of the road with the new housing development on Rempstone Road. The 40mph will reduce the speed of traffic approaching the 30mph speed limit.
