

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Spring Lane, Lambley and Mapperley)(30 M.P.H. Speed Limit) Restricted Road Order 2021 (7228)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council HAS MADE an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effects of which will be to roads in Lambley and Mapperley in the Borough of Gedling:-

The following length of road shall be a restricted road (30mph):-

Spring Lane

from a point 42 metres (as measured along the centre line) south-east of its junction with Mapperley Plains (the outer perimeter of the mini-roundabout) in a south-easterly direction to a point 17 metres east of its junction with Hartland Drive.

The speed limit has replaced the previous 40mph speed limit. The speed limit will remain at 40mph between near Hartland Drive and Lambley. The lower speed limit covers all the residential roads off Spring Lane and will give more time for drivers to react to turning vehicles. The lower speed limit will bring benefits to the vulnerable users of Spring Lane, i.e cyclists, horse riders and pedestrians.
