

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Surgeys Lane, Arnold) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2023 (7259)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council HAS MADE an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be to roads in Arnold in the Borough of Gedling:-

1. Proposed No waiting at any time restrictions (double yellow lines) at the following locations:-

(i) <u>SURGEYS LANE (the north-west side)</u>

from a point opposite a point 42 metres south-west of its junction with Albion Rise in a south-westerly and then a north-easterly direction to its junction with Calverton Road.

(ii) <u>SURGEYS LANE (the south-east side)</u>

from a point 42 metres south-west of its junction with Albion Rise in a south-westerly direction to its junction with Calverton Road.

The double yellow lines have been introduced to remove parked vehicles from the bend on Surgeys Lane on the approach to the junction with Calverton Road. The restrictions will make it easier and safer for vehicles, especially larger vehicles, to negotiate the bend.

THE ORDER WILL COME INTO FORCE ON THE 10th DAY OF MARCH 2023.
