

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(WOOD LANE AND YEW TREE LANE, GEDLING)
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023 (7250)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council HAS MADE an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Gedling in the Borough of Gedling: -

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from **Waiting At Any Time** along the following lengths of road: -

Wood Lane, Gedling (north side)

- From a point opposite a point 11 metres north-east of the northern kerb line of the entrance of Carlton le Willows Academy in a south-westerly direction for 16 metres.

Wood Lane, Gedling (south side)

- From the northern kerb line of the entrance of Carlton le Willows Academy in a northerly direction for 12 metres.

Yew Tree Lane, Gedling (both sides)

- From its junction with Wood Lane in a north-westerly direction for 10 metres.

2. Vehicles will be prohibited from **Waiting Mon-Fri 8am-6pm** along the following lengths of road: -

Wood Lane, Gedling (south side)

- from a point 42 metres north-east of its junction with Shearing Hill in a north-easterly direction to its junction with the entrance to Carlton le Willows Academy.

The works will improve visibility and access for drivers and pedestrians along Wood Lane and at the junction of Wood Lane/ Yew Tree Lane.
