

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 The Nottinghamshire County Council (High Street and Mattersey Road, Everton)(Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2021 (1248)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council HAS MADE an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Everton in the District of Bassetlaw: -

Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at any time along: -

HIGH STREET (the east side)

- (i) from a point 17 metres north of its junction with Gainsborough Road (A631) in a northerly direction for 5 metres.
- (ii) from a point 56 metres north of its junction with Gainsborough Road (A631) in a northerly direction for 43 metres.

HIGH STREET (the west side)

- (iii) from its junction with Gainsborough Road (A631) in a northerly direction for 17 metres.
- (iv) from a point 49 metres north of its junction with Gainsborough Road (A631) in a northerly direction for 37 metres.

MATTERSEY ROAD (both sides)

(v) from its junction with Gainsborough Road (A631) in a southerly direction for 12 metres.

As a result of the impact of COVID-19 and in accordance with Public Health England's advice on social distancing and avoiding non-essential trips, public buildings such as County Hall and libraries are closed or if reopened will have restrictions in place.

THIS ORDER WILL COME INTO FORCE ON THE 11TH DAY OF MARCH 2021.

The double yellow lines have been introduced to remove parked vehicles from the junctions off Gainsborough Road (A631) and the narrow length of road between Corner Farm Drive and Metcalfe Court. The restrictions at the junctions will help ensure that the vehicles turning on or off Gainsborough Road are not obstructed by parked vehicles. The double yellow lines opposite Metcalfe Court will make it easier for vehicles turning out onto High Street.
