

## Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 The Nottinghamshire County Council (Highfield Drive and Standhill Road, Carlton)(Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2020 (7227)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council HAS MADE an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Carlton in the Borough of Gedling: -

- Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at any time along: -
- (i) <u>HIGHFIELD DRIVE (north-west side)</u> from its junction with Standhill Road in a north-easterly direction for 7 metres.
- (ii) <u>HIGHFIELD DRIVE (south-east side)</u> from its junction with Standhill Road in a north-easterly direction for 7 metres.
- (iii) <u>STANDHILL ROAD</u> (the north-east side) from a point 12 metres north-west of its junction with Highfield Drive in a south-easterly direction to a point 12 metres south-east of the same junction.

As a result of the impact of COVID-19 and in accordance with Public Health England's advice on social distancing and avoiding non-essential trips, public buildings such as County Hall and libraries are closed or if reopened will have restrictions in place.

## THIS ORDER WILL COME INTO FORCE ON THE 20<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF NOVEMBER 2020.

The restrictions have replaced the previous white line and "PATROL" markings at the junction of Highfield Drive and Standhill Road. The double yellow lines will help ensure that vehicles do not park in the vicinity of the junction. The removal of parked vehicles will give an unobstructed route for pedestrians, especially children attending the school on Standhill Road. Vehicles turning out of Highfield Drive will have a better view of traffic on Standhill Road.
