

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Penniment Lane, Sutton-in-Ashfield) (Restricted Road (30 M.P.H. Speed Limit)) Order 2021 (4240)

The Council of the County of Nottinghamshire ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. The length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order shall be a restricted road for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.
- 2. Any previous speed limit order made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or any enactment replaced by that Act in so far as it related to the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order is hereby revoked.
- 3. This Order may be cited as "The Nottinghamshire County Council (Penniment Lane, Sutton-in-Ashfield) (Restricted Road (30 M.P.H. Speed Limit)) Order 2021 (4240)" and shall come into force on the **3**rd day of **February 2021**

SCHEDULE 1

Length of Penniment Lane (the north-east to south-west section) at Sutton-in-Ashfield in the District of Ashfield

From its junction with Penniment Lane (the north-west to south-east section) in a south-westerly direction for 290 metres to its south-western extremity.
