NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Attenbourgh and Chilwell in the Borough of Broxtowe:-

1. The following length of road shall be a restricted road (30mph) for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act:-

A6005 Nottingham Road, Attenborough – from a point 258 metres north-east of its junction with Swiney Way in a north-easterly direction to its junction with Attenborough Lane

A6005 Bye-Pass Road, Chilwell - from its junction with Attenborough Lane in a north-easterly direction to a point 122 metres south-west of its junction with Bye Pass Road

2. The following Order is hereby revoked in so far as it relates to the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order:-

The Trunk Roads (Beeston, Chilwell and Toton) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 1962

3. Any previous speed limit order made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or any enactment replace by that Act in so far as it related to the lengths of road specified in the Schedules to this Order are hereby revoked.
