<u>The Nottinghamshire County Council (Lilac Grove, Beeston) (7.5T Environmental Weight Restriction) Traffic Regulation Order 2020 (5262)</u>

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL **Has Made** an Order under Sections 1 and 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The effect of the Order are that, in respect of roads at Beeston in the Borough of Broxtowe, no heavy commercial vehicle shall proceed along the following length of road:-.

Lilac Grove, Beeston in the Borough of Broxtowe

(i) from its junction with Meadow Road in a north-easterly direction to a point 54 metres north-east of its junction with Lilac Crescent / Maple Avenue.

As a result of the impact of COVID-19 and in accordance with Public Health England's advice on social distancing and avoiding non-essential trips, public buildings such at County Hall libraries are closed or if reopened will have restrictions in place.

The purpose of the Order is to prevent the use of the road by heavy commercial vehicles in a manner which is unsuitable, having regard to the existing character of the road or adjoining property. Exemptions will apply to vehicles requiring access to premises within the restricted length of road.
