

## Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

### The Nottinghamshire County Council (James Street, Kimberley) (Parking Places) Traffic Regulation Order 2020 (5265)

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Kimberley in the Borough of Broxtowe: -

1. To provide residents' parking places operating Monday to Saturday 8am to 6pm along **James Street, Kimberley** - from a point 14 metres north-east of its junction with High Street in a north-easterly direction to a point 55 metres north-east of that junction
2. To provide 2 hours parking, no return within 1 hour. Operating Monday to Saturday 8am - 6pm along: -

#### **James Street, (the south-east side)**

- from a point 7 metres south-west of its junction with Main Street in a south-westerly direction for 57 metres
- from a point 69 metres south-west of its junction with Main Street in a south-westerly direction for 15 metres
- from a point 86 metres south-west of its junction with Main Street in a south-westerly direction for 5 metres

3. Vehicles will be prohibited from **waiting at any time** along the following: -

From a point 55 metres north-east of its junction with High Street in a north-easterly direction to a point 65 metres north-east of that junction

As a result of the impact of COVID-19 and in accordance with Public Health England's advice on social distancing and avoiding non-essential trips, public buildings such as County Hall libraries are closed or if reopened will have restrictions in place.

The provision is required to improve parking facilities for residents by removing non-residential parked vehicles from the south-western end of James Street, Kimberley. Non-resident parking at the north-eastern end will be increased from 1 to 2 hours.
