

**The Nottinghamshire County Council (James Street, Kimberley)**  
**(Parking Places and Residents' Controlled Zone)**

**Traffic Regulation Order 2020 (5265)**

**Statement of Reasons**

Nottinghamshire County Council has received complaints, via the local County Councillor, regarding issues with intrusive commuter / shopper parking along James Street at Kimberley. It is therefore proposed to introduce a Residents' Parking Scheme (RPS) that would be in operation Monday to Saturday from 8am – 6pm, between its junction with High Street and the Car Park.

In May 2019, questionnaires were sent to the 12 affected properties within the proposed boundary of the RPS. Overall there were 6 (50%) completed questionnaires returned, all 6 (100%) were in favour. In order for the County Council to consider the introduction of an RPS there has to be 35% of the questionnaires returned and of these 65% must be in favour. As you can see these results fall well within the criteria.

In addition to the proposed Residents' Parking Scheme, it is proposed to change the existing 1 hour parking, between the car park and its junction with Main Street, to 2 hours parking, no return within 1 hour.
