

<u>The Nottinghamshire County Council (Longden Terrace, Warsop)</u> <u>(Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2022 (2245)</u>

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **HAS MADE** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Warsop in the District of Mansfield: -

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting Monday to Friday, 8.00am-4.30pm along the following: -

Longden Terrace, Warsop (the east side)

• From a point 60 metres north-west of its junction with Titchfield Street in a north-westerly direction for 8 metres.
