

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Balderton Gate, South, Newark on Trent)
(Parking Places and Residents' Controlled Zone)
Traffic Regulation Order 2022 (3313)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **HAS MADE** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be to roads in Newark on Trent in the District of Newark and Sherwood: -

1. To provide residents' parking places operating Monday to Saturday 9am to 5pm along

BALDERTON GATE- SOUTH, ZONE A- (NEWARK ON TRENT) (north-east side)

- from a point 33 metres north-west of its junction with William Street in a south-easterly direction to a point 8 metres north -west of its junction with William Street.
- from a point 8 metres south-east of its junction with William Street in a south-easterly direction for 24 metres.
- from a point 38 metres south-east of its junction with William Street in a south-easterly direction for 18 metres

BALDERTON GATE – SOUTH, ZONE-A (NEWARK ON TRENT) (south-west side)

- from a point 33 metres south-east of its junction with Sherwood Avenue in a south-easterly direction for 18 metres

2. To provide 2 hours parking, no return within 1 hour. Operating Monday to Saturday 9am – 5pm along: -

BALDERTON GATE (NEWARK ON TRENT) (north-east side)

- from a point 53 metres north-west of its junction with William Street in a south-easterly direction for 17 metres.
- from a point 33 metres north-west of its junction with William Street in a south-easterly direction to a point 8 metres north-west of its junction with William Street.
- from a point 8 metres south-east of its junction with William Street in a south-easterly direction for 24 metres.
- from a point 38 metres south-east of its junction with William Street in a south-easterly direction for 18 metres

BALDERTON GATE (NEWARK ON TRENT) (south-west side)

- from a point 33 metres south-east of its junction with Sherwood Avenue in a south-easterly direction for 18 metres.
