

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Balderton Gate, South, Newark on Trent) (Parking Places and Residents' Controlled Zone) Traffic Regulation Order 2022 (3313)

Statement of Reasons

Via East Midlands is working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council to deliver highway services.

Nottinghamshire County Council has received complaints, regarding issues with intrusive commuter / shopper parking along Balderton Gate, Newark on Trent. It is therefore proposed to introduce a Dual-purpose Residents' Parking Bays and 2-hour parking (no return in 1 hour) that would be in operation Monday to Saturday from 9am – 5pm, between its junctions with Sherwood Avenue and Whitfield Street, Newark on Trent.

In November 2021, questionnaires were sent to the affected properties within the proposed boundary of the Resident Parking Scheme. Overall, there were 15 (40%) completed questionnaires returned, (80%) were in favour. In order for the County Council to consider the introduction of an RPS there has to be 35% of the questionnaires returned and of these 65% must be in favour. As you can see these results fall within the criteria.
