

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Boy Lane and High Street, Edwinstowe) (Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2021 (3339)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **HAS MADE** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Edwinstowe in the District of Mansfield: -

Vehicles will be prohibited from Waiting At Any Time along the following lengths of road: -

Boy Lane, Edwinstowe (the north-west side)

• From its junction with High Street in a north-easterly direction for 19 metres.

Boy Lane, Edwinstowe (the south-east side)

• From its junction with High Street in a north-easterly direction for 44 metres.

<u>High Street, Edwinstowe</u> (the north-east side)

• From a point 13 metres north-west of its junction with Boy Lane in a south-easterly direction to a point 15 metres south-east of that junction.

<u>High Street, Edwinstowe</u> (the south-west side)

• From a point 10 metres north-west of its junction with Friend Lane in a south-easterly direction to a point 5 metres south-east of that junction.
