**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (SEARWOOD AVENUE AND
SUTTON ROAD, KIRKBY-IN-ASHFIELD) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC
REGULATION ORDER 2019 (4249)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Kirkby-in-Ashfield in the District of Ashfield: -

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at any time along: -

SEARWOOD AVENUE, KIRKBY-IN-ASHFIELD (the north side)

- From its junction with Sutton Road in a westerly direction for 11 metres

SEARWOOD AVENUE, KIRKBY-IN-ASHFIELD (the south side)

- From its junction with Sutton Road in a westerly direction for 10 metres

SUTTON ROAD, KIRKBY-IN-ASHFIELD (the west side)

- From a point 2 metres north of its junction with Searwood Avenue in a southerly direction to a point 10 metres south of that junction
