

**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (SHELFORD ROAD AND WOLLATON  
AVENUE, GEDLING) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2025  
(7288)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Gedling the Borough of Gedling: -

1. Proposed **prohibition of Waiting At Any Time** along the following lengths of road: -

**Shelford Road, (Gedling)** (the north-east side)

From a point **14** meters north-east of its junction with Wollaton Avenue in a south westerly direction to a point **10** meters south-west of that junction.

**Wollaton Avenue, (Gedling)** (the south-west side)

From its junction with Shelford Road in a south-easterly direction for **11** meters

**Wollaton Avenue, (Gedling)** (the north-east side side)

From its junction with Shelford Road in a south easterly direction for **10** meters

2. Proposed **Bus Stop Clearways – No Stopping at any time except buses** along the following lengths of road: -

**SHELFORD ROAD, GEDLING** (the south-west side)

From a point opposite a point **10** meters north west of its junction with Wollaton Avenue in a south westerly direction for **19** meters.
