

SHELFORD ROAD, RADCLIFFE-ON-TRENT (BETWEEN GRANDFIELD AVENUE & QUEENS ROAD) - PROPOSED ZEBRA CROSSING WITH RAISED JUNCTION PLATEAU AND SHELFORD ROAD, RADCLIFFE ON TRENT (BETWEEN PARK ROAD AND WAKEFIELD AVENUE) PROPOSED RAISED ZEBRA CROSSING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (zebra crossing) proposes to install two zebra crossings across Shelford Road. And Section 90A - 90I of the Highways Act 1980 (traffic calming hump), proposes to install a raised traffic calming plateau (junction table) on Shelford Road, Grandfield Avenue and Queens Road and a flat-topped hump on Shelford Road, between Park Road and Wakefield Avenue, Radcliffe on Trent in the Borough of Rushcliffe: -

1. The proposals will incorporate a controlled area indicated by zig-zag markings along the carriageway where **parking, stopping and loading will be prohibited**. The extents of the controlled area are: -

SHELFORD ROAD, RADCLIFFE ON TRENT (the north-west side)

- From a point 8.5 metres south-west of its junction with Grandfield Avenue in a north-easterly direction for 40.5 metres
- From a point 6.5 metres south-west of its junction with Park Road in a north-easterly direction for 46 metres.

SHELFORD ROAD, RADCLIFFE ON TRENT (the south-east side)

- From a point 29 metres south-west of its junction with Queens Road in a north-easterly direction for 40.5 metres.
- From a point 40 metres south-west of its junction with Wakefield Avenue in a north-easterly direction for 50 metres.

2. The crossings will be constructed on a 75mm high raised traffic calming plateau (junction table), the effects of which will be: -

SHELFORD ROAD, RADCLIFFE ON TRENT

- From a point 17.25 metres south-west of its junction with Grandfield Avenue in a north-easterly direction for 55 metres.
- From a point 11 meters north-east of its junction with Park Road in a north-easterly direction for 9.5 metres.

GRANDFIELD AVENUE, RADCLIFFE ON TRENT

- From its junction with Shelford Road in a north-westerly direction for 10.5 metres.

QUEENS ROAD, RADCLIFFE ON TRENT

- From its junction with Shelford Road in a south-easterly direction for 10.5 metres.

The crossings are being installed to improve pedestrian facilities on Shelford Road. The junction table is intended to slow vehicles down on the approaches to the crossings.
