

<u>The Nottinghamshire County Council (Shireoaks Common,</u> <u>Shireoaks)(Derestriction) Order 2018 (1223)</u>

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be to roads in Shireoaks in the District of Bassetlaw:-

1. <u>Shireoaks Common</u> - from a point 91 metres north-west of its junction with Coach Road in a south-easterly direction to its junction with the A57 roundabout. The road shall cease to be a restricted road for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.

This order is being introduced to allow the existing 30mph speed limit on Shireoaks Common to be extended towards the A57 roundabout. The new length of 30mph speed limit would include the new junctions into the housing development to the north-east and south-west of Shireoaks Common. The road would be 30mph by virtue of the existing street lights. The derestriction order is intended to keep the length of Shireoaks Common, between the new 30mph speed limit and the A57, at the current National Speed Limit of 60mph.
