## RAGNARS WALK, SOOKHOLME LANE, THE HAWTHORNS AND THORLEAF WAY, MARKET WARSOP – PROPOSED PARKING RESTRICTIONS – DOUBLE YELLOW LINES (TRO 2258) – PUBLIC CONSULTATION

Via East Midlands Ltd, is working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council to deliver highway services in Nottinghamshire. Following on from the initial consultation, that was carried out in June 2023, the proposals are now being publicly advertised with notices in the Nottingham Post and on site. The proposals are unchanged from those contained in the initial consultation.

The proposals are being carried out as a result of the new housing development off Sookholme Lane, Market Warsop. It is proposed to introduce double yellow lines (no waiting at any time) at the following locations:-

- Junction of Sookholme Lane/The Hawthorns
- Junction of Sookholme Lane/Ragnars Walk
- Junction of Ragnars Walk/Thorleaf Way
- Turning head at end of Ragnars Walk
- Turning head at end of Thorleaf Way (south-west to north-east section)

The proposed double yellow lines will help to ensure that parked vehicles do not restrict visibility for vehicles turning in or out of the junctions. The restrictions will also ensure that there is a clear route for pedestrians to cross the road. The restrictions at the turning heads will help ensure that vehicles can turn around and residents can access the private drives off the turning heads. The locations and details of the restrictions are shown on the enclosed draft drawing (H/JAB/4253/01) and notice.

Before proceeding further with the proposed double yellow lines, I wish to consider the views of residents and organisations who may be interested in this matter. If your comments are in the form of an objection to the proposals and if they cannot be resolved, they will be reported through the County Council's procedures at the appropriate time. Any observations on these proposals should reach me by **16th August 2023**.
