

**PROVISION OF PEDESTRIAN PUFFIN CROSSING ON
SOUTHWELL ROAD EAST, RAINWORTH**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 proposes to install a pedestrian puffin crossing on Southwell Road East, in the District of Mansfield approximately 22 metres south-east of a point opposite the centre line of its junction with Blidworth Lane on the north-east side of the road and 24 metres south-east of the centre line of the same junction on the south-west side.

The crossing will incorporate a controlled area, indicated by zig-zag markings along the carriageway where parking, stopping and loading will be prohibited. The extents of the controlled areas are:-

SOUTHWELL ROAD EAST, RAINWORTH (the north-east side)

- From a point opposite the centre line of its junction with Blidworth Lane in a south-easterly direction for 44 metres.

SOUTHWELL ROAD EAST, RAINWORTH (the south-west side)

- From a point 15 metres south-east of the centre line of its junction with Blidworth Lane in a south-easterly direction for 31 metres.

The crossing is being installed to assist pedestrians in crossing the road, the number of pedestrians is expected to increase due to the new housing developments on Blidworth Lane. There are currently no formal crossing points on Southwell Road East.
