

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (OUTRAM STREET, SUTTON IN ASHFIELD) TRAFFIC CALMING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of powers conferred by Section 90A - 90I of the Highways Act 1980 propose to provide additional 'Traffic Calming' features on Outram Street, Sutton in Ashfield between No's 1 & 37.

The effects of which will be to:-

Install sets of speed cushions at two locations; including two cushions in the carriageway, maximum 1800mm wide and a smaller cushion in the parking bay.

One set of 3 Speed Cushions maximum 75mm high outside property number 17; second set of 3 Speed Cushions maximum 75mm high outside property number 29.

The proposed traffic calming features are to reduce traffic collisions occurring along the route.

As a result of the impact of COVID-19 and in accordance with Public Health England's advice on social distancing and avoiding non-essential trips, public buildings such as County Hall and libraries are closed or if reopened will have restrictions in place.
