

## **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**

# The Nottinghamshire County (Barbara Square, Hucknall) (Prohibition of Waiting) <u>Traffic Regulation Order 2021 (4275)</u>

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads in Hucknall in the District of Ashfield -

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at any time along: -

### BARBARA SQUARE, HUCKNALL (north side)

- From a point 12 metres west of the boundary between No 24 and No 26 in westerly direction then north-westerly direction for 15 metres.
- From a point 14 metres east of the boundary between No 24 and No 26 in an easterly direction and then north-easterly direction for 13 metres

### BARBARA SQUARE, HUCKNALL (north west side)

• From a point 74 metres east of its junction with Annesley Road in a north-easterly direction and then northerly direction for 18 metres.

#### BARBARA SQUARE, HUCKNALL (south side)

- From the boundary between No 45 and No 47 in south-westerly direction and then westerly direction for 22 metres.
- From a point 3 metres south of the boundary between No 73 and No 75 in a southeasterly direction and then easterly direction for 23 metres

#### BARBARA SQUARE, HUCKNALL (south west side)

• From a point 74 metres east of its junction with Annesley Road in a north-easterly direction and then south-easterly direction for 18 metres.
